FLITWICK TOWN MAYOR'S CHARITY Barrel of Booze Raffle rules

Thank you for supporting FLITWICK TOWN MAYOR'S CHARITY (CIO - **1205683**) These terms and conditions refer to online and, in person entry to our raffle.

1. The cost of each ticket entry into the FLITWICK TOWN MAYOR'S CHARITY Wheelbarrow of Booze Raffle is £5 You may purchase more than one ticket, but the maximum number of tickets is one hundred (£100) per draw. Payment to enter the raffle must be made in advance of the draw date. Any payment received after the draw date will be treated as a donation.
2. No tickets can be sold to, on behalf of, or for a person under the age of 18 years. The Promoter reserves the right to carry out age verification checks.
3. If a ticket is sold unknowingly to, on behalf of, or for a person under the age of 18 they will be exempt from the raffle and will forfeit their prize and the stake will be returned.
4. The FLITWICK TOWN MAYOR'S CHARITY Barrel of Booze Raffle is open to all Great Britain residents aged 18 years and over, except named trustees of the FLITWICK TOWN MAYOR'S CHARITY that are directly involved with the raffle.
5. The prizes are as follows –

1st Prize – Large Wheelbarrow of Booze (Contents only) - One available

2nd Prize – Small Wheelbarrow of Booze (Contents only) One available
6. The Raffle ticket sales will take place from the 27th June 2024, sales will still stop on 31st July 2024 at Midnight. The winner will be contacted by email / phone.
7. The Wheelbarrow is not included in the prize and is for promotion purposes only.
8. The prize will be required to be collected from The Rufus Centre, Steppingley Road Flitwick , MK45 1AH
9. Monies raised by this raffle will support the activities of FLITWICK TOWN MAYOR'S CHARITY , registered charity number **1205683** and any charity that the Town Mayor nominates within their elected period. This is currently the Keech Hospice Care Charity Number - **1035089**
10. Raffle tickets will be entered into the draw only when the whole payment is received.
11. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for raffle tickets which are lost, damaged, illegible or from which the prize winner cannot be identified, or for any technical failure or event which may cause the competition to be disrupted or corrupted.
12. Any ticket entries received after the closing date will miss entry into the draw and therefore will be considered as a donation.
 - A random generator will be used to select the winner.

- The result of the raffle draw is final. No correspondence will be entered into. Please keep the ticket or allocated number as proof of purchase.
 - Where the Promoter is unable to contact a prize winner and the prize remains unclaimed for 1 month following the Promoter's first attempt to notify the prize winner, the Promoter may apply the prize as it sees fit, including re-offering the prize in future raffles.
13. All winners are required to co-operate with the Promoter's right to publish their win as and when deemed appropriate, and to provide proof of age when requested.

In the event of an error, howsoever caused, whether a printing error or otherwise and whether obvious or otherwise, which affects the competition in any way, the Promoter reserves the right to administer the raffle as though the error had not occurred. Where the Promoter deems it appropriate and/or feasible it will notify entrants of the error.
15. Failure to comply with any of these rules may result in the disqualification of the entry. The Promoter reserves the right to disqualify any entry at their absolute discretion.
16. Refunds for payment of raffle tickets will only be given under the following circumstance:
- a duplicate payment was taken due to an FLITWICK TOWN MAYOR'S CHARITY technical connection failure
